Applications for, or amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Broxtowe Borough Council, Council Offices, Foster Avenue, Beeston, Nottingham, NG9 1AB by 5pm on Monday, 14 April 2025. Applications to vote by post can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 23 April 2025.
